- Heavy rains occurred in eastern Uttar Pradesh and parts of Bihar in the last 24 hours.
- Mirzapur in Eastern Uttar Pradesh received very heavy rains (270 mm on a single day) causing water logging/partial damage to standing pulse crops
- Punjab, Haryana continued to receive rains recharging the groundwater
- Rains in Bihar after a long dry spell provided excellent relief to rice crop in most districts
