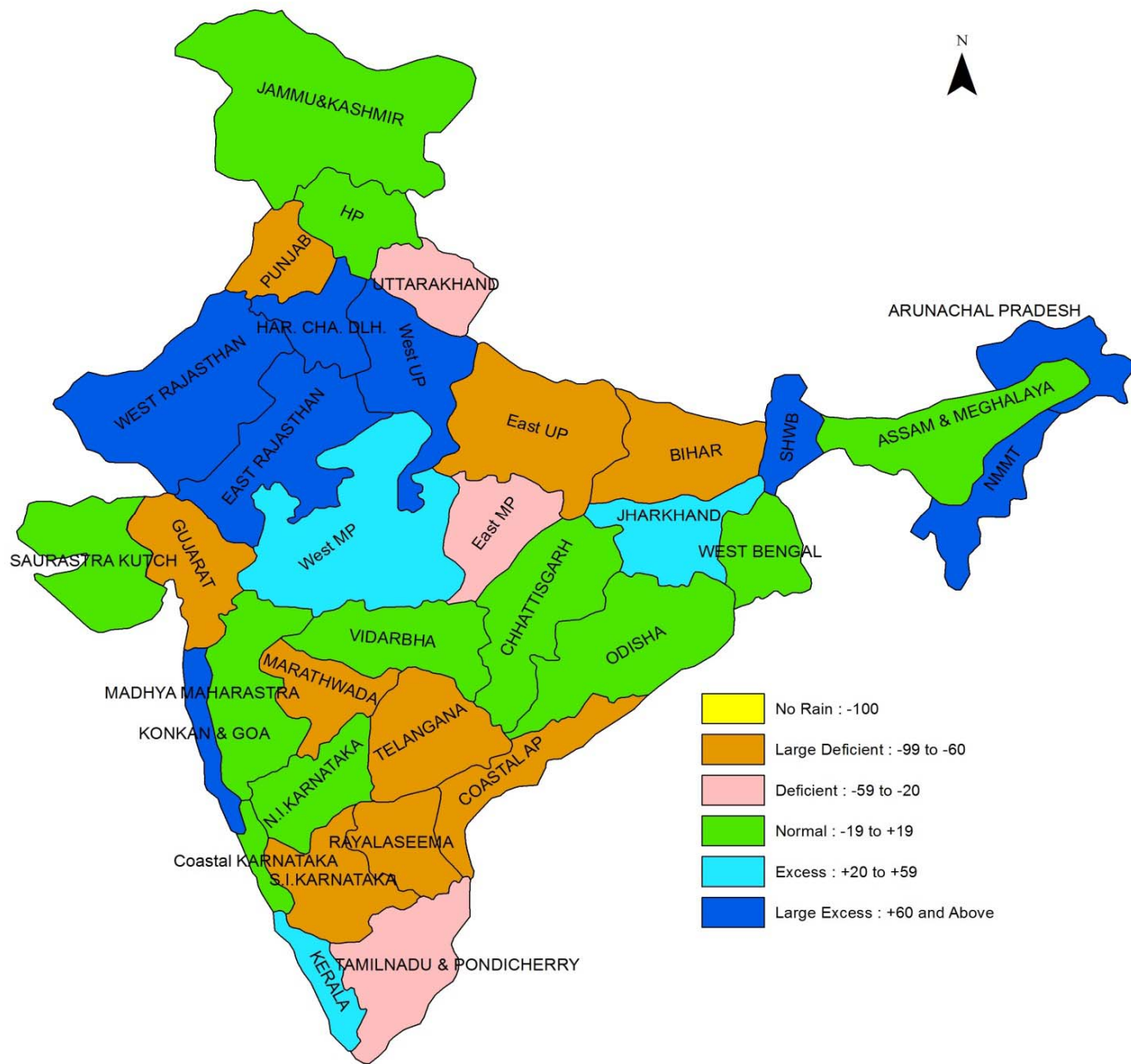

2. SW monsoon advanced into some more parts of Arunachal Pradesh, NMMT, Assam-Meghalaya
3. Conditions are favourable for further advance of southwest monsoon into coastal & south interior Karnataka and Rayalaseema and some more parts of Tamilnadu during next 48 hours.
