India Meteorological Department (IMD), through its Agrometorological Field Units (AMFUs), which are operated in collaboration with State Agriculture Universities and other Institutes, issues Agrometeorological advisory service.. This contains advisories for all the weather sensitive agricultural operations form sowing to harvest. It also includes advisories for horticultural crops and livestock.. These weather based advisories are disseminated to the farmers through mass media dissemination, Internet etc as well as through district level intermediaries. The advisories will be communicated through multi-channel dissemination system.
