Cyclone FANI

Latest report published(June 25th) on the impact of Cyclone Fani stated that it has affected three states Odisha, Andhra Pradesh and West Bengal. In Orissa, 148,663 hectare of crop land affected and 1,365 hectare crop area was damaged in Andhra Pradesh. In West Bengal, 112,000 hectare of crop area was affected.

Cyclone VAYU

On 12 and 13th June the very severe cyclonic storm 'VAYU' set over southwest of Diu, Veraval, Junagarh, Dwaraka and south of Porbandar Gujarat. But on 16th June Cyclone Vayu took recurve and posed no threat to the Gujarat state as it had moved east and northeastwards weekened into a depression on 18th June. No agriculture damage was recorded or reported officially during this period in any reports.
