However, the information gathered from relevant source on the impact of Fani cyclone on crops and other related sectors is furnished below for your kind information

- In Odisha, more than 33% crop has been damaged due to Cyclone Fani that hit the eastern coastline last week. The districts affected by Fani are: Puri, Khurda, Cuttack, Mayurbhanj, Keonjhar, Balasore, Bhadrak, Jajpur, Angul, Dhenkanal, Nayagarh, Ganjam, Kendrapara and Jagatsinghpur.
- Summer crops, orchards, plantations devastated in a large scale
- In 88 blocks, in 14 districts about One Lakh Fifty Two Thousand Nine Hundred Eighty Five hectare agriculture land has been damaged.
- Horticultural crops like mango, cashew and plantation crops like coconuts were also hard hit.
- FANI Cyclone has dented the State's animal husbandry and dairy sector. In Pipili Block of the Puri district, approximately 750,000 poultry birds have been perished.
- A large number of birds, mostly broilers, were killed," said Saurabh Garg, Principal Secretary, Odisha's Department of Agriculture. According to the latest situation report, poultry casualties had hit 34.52 lakh, and more than 53 lakh birds were affected.
